First Session:

Registration:

Monday June 9th or Tuesday June 10th from
8:00 am – 2:00 pm.

Tickets are required for first day of registration only. We will start giving out tickets at 7:00 am as some classes will sell out. Class availability is first come, first served.

- **Monday June 16th – Thursday July 3rd**
(No school held on the 4th of July)
- **Each class is 1 hour and runs Monday – Friday.**
- **School hours are 9:00 am – 2:00 pm daily**

Registration Fees:

- Registration fee - \$45.00
plus \$35.00 per class
- **Fees are non-refundable** and due in full at the time of registration.
- Payments can be made by cash, check (payable to Valley High School), money order, or credit card (**MasterCard, VISA, or Discover Card only**).
